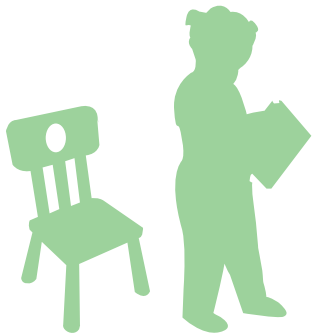


Quality Counts

Quality Counts (QC) is a voluntary rating system that reviews early learning programs in Miami-Dade County according to a five-star method of evaluation that clearly defines high-quality standards. Quality Counts goals are to:



Ensure young children throughout Miami-Dade County are provided with the best possible early learning experiences through high-quality early learning programs

Provide information and support to early learning programs to improve and sustain the quality of their programs

Provide families with a resource to select the best program for their child.

Quality Counts provides support services and financial incentives to providers which include:

- Grants for materials and equipment
- Educational scholarships for staff
- Technical assistance
- Wage supplements for staff
