



Affordable Child Care Solutions

The Child Care Executive Partnership (CCEP) helps working-families afford quality child care.

WHAT? Employers who participate in the CCEP program contribute money to help employees reduce the costs for child care. Through federal and state funding, your employer's contributions are matched dollar-for-dollar with money from the CCEP. Parents pay a portion based on a sliding fee scale.

WHY? Employers understand the challenges of caring for family and managing a career. They also understand that being late and taking time off from work because of child care issues can affect their bottom line. The CCEP is a solution for both.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE? First, ask your employer, manager or human resources manager if your company is already a member of the CCEP. If not, contact the Early Learning Coalition so we can provide you and your employer with information and participation eligibility. The Early Learning Coalition can speak directly with your employer about joining the CCEP program.
