



Child Screening & Assessment

1. Is there a preference as to the font and margins?
[RFP only specifies 12 font, double spaced.12 font, double spaced.]

Answer: **There is no preference to the font. Margins should be no less than 1-inch margins.**

2. Page 9 Screening and Assessment of RFP – Program Management scoring factor #1 – Is the requested “organizational and program flow chart of program’s management” for the entire department or the division? Should we show current program staffing or proposed program on flow chart?

Answer: **Please provide a flow chart that adequately describes your organizational management.**

3. Page 12 – What is meant by “Inform overall Program Planning and Management”. Does this refer to the program planning/management of the provider or the County program?

Answer: **Overall program planning and management refers to the Child Screening and Assessment program as identified by F.S. 411.**

4. Page 13 Educational requirements- What is considered “related fields”?

Answer: **Related fields as it relates to early childhood education.**

5. The RFP does not specify if the screening tool to be used is the ASQ 3 which can be used for children 2 months to five years. The previous form of the ASQ does not contain questionnaires for 2 month old children.

Answer: **The Ages and Stages Questionnaire is the screening tool to be used as identified on Page 12: Purpose.**

6. Are the families or the providers expected to complete the A & S Q?

Answer: **The Ages and Stages Questionnaire is to be completed by the providers with the family as often as possible.**

7. Is it the A & S Q or the A & S Q- S E to be included? Is it just the developmental screening or does it include the social-emotional component?

Answer: For the purpose of this RFP, the Coalition will use the ASQ developmental screening tool and does not include the social-emotional component.

8. The pre-post test using the LAP-D or E-LAP is to be administered when a child enters and then exits the program. When do the children enter and exit the program? Is it at a particular time in the year or by birth month as the screening is scheduled to be done?

Answer: Pre-test period is August- October 15 and post test period will be April-June 1st.

9. In addition to the A & S Q, would the grantor be opposed to adding the Web-based version of the DECA to provide social-emotional information?

Answer: There is no opposition but would have to be a consideration for contract negotiations.
